

COVID-19 Vaccine & Breast Milk Study



The COVID-19 vaccine is here but there is currently little to no information about its use by breastfeeding women, including its safety and whether any immunity a mom develops is passed to her baby in breast milk. To help answer these important questions, we are currently enrolling breastfeeding women who receive the COVID-19 vaccine into our breast milk study.

Participation includes:



- Providing up to 7 breast milk samples in the 45 days after you receive the vaccine. All samples can be collected from the comfort of your home, and all materials for collecting and shipping the samples are provided.



- Up to 3 phone interviews



- Authorizing release of medical records for yourself and your baby



- Mailed or online questionnaires about your baby's development
